Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a new restaurant-winery permit. The permit authorizes a restaurant to manufacture its own wine and to sell that wine at retail from the premises for consumption on or off the restaurant's premises. The permit is issued by the Department of Revenue and may be issued only for a restaurant in which the sale of alcohol beverages accounts for less than 50% of gross receipts and which manufactures less than 5,000 gallons of wine per year.

This bill would have a minimal effect, if any, on state revenue.

Local alcohol license revenue may decrease, because a local license would not be needed if the restaurant only sells wine manufactured on the premises. However, a local license would still be required if the establishment sold wine or alcohol not manufactured on the premises.
