~~Green Bay Packers, a professional football team. DOT may not issue special group plates related to the Green Bay Packers until six months after any approvals that are required for use of an applicable logo, trademark, trade name or commercial symbol designating the team have been obtained.~~

~~In addition to the regular vehicle registration fee, the special group members are required to pay a \$15 fee for issuance or reissuance of the special plates and an additional \$25 annual fee as a tax deductible contribution that, after payment of certain data processing and licensing fee costs, provides funds to United Way of Wisconsin, a nonprofit corporation, for programs and activities relating to charitable services and for the payment of marketing costs relating to the special group plates. Under the bill, United Way of Wisconsin is required to annually submit an audited financial statement of its use of the funds received from these tax deductible contributions. Funding to United Way of Wisconsin is discontinued if the nonprofit organization dissolves or loses its tax-exempt status under federal law.~~

Current law also prohibits enumerating special group license plates by legislative action. Instead, members of special groups desiring a special group license plate must apply to DOT for designation. This bill creates an exception to this administrative process.

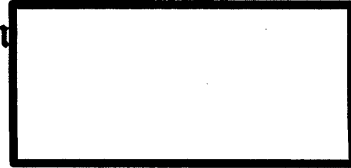
