AN ACT to create 19.36 (10) of the statutes; relating to: access to public records
2 containing social security account numbers of individuals.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 19.36 (10) of the statutes is created to read:
4 19.36 (10) SOCIAL SECURITY ACCOUNT NUMBERS. If a record or portion of a record
5 contains the social security account number of any individual together with
6 information revealing the identity of that individual, an authority shall delete the
7 social security account number before permitting access to the record under s. 19.35
8 (1), unless the requester is specifically authorized to have access to the social security
9 account number by federal or state law.
