- 4 "Section 3m. 20.275 (1) (es) of the statutes is amended to read:
 - 20.275 (1) (es) *Principal, interest and rebates; general purpose revenue*—school districts. A sum sufficient to reimburse s. 20.866 (1) (u) for the payment of principal and interest costs incurred in financing subsidized educational technology infrastructure loans to school districts under s. 44.72 (4) (a) and to make full payment of the amounts determined by the building commission under s. 13.488 (1) (m), to the extent that these costs and payments are not paid under par. (h).".
 - **3.** Page 3, line 9: after that line insert:
- **"Section 4m.** 20.275 (1) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.275 (1) (h) Principal, interest and rebates; program revenue — school
$districts.$ All moneys received $\underline{from\ school\ districts}$ under s. 44.72 (4) (c) to reimburse
s. 20.866 (1) (u) for the payment of principal and interest costs incurred in financing
$subsidized\ educational\ technology\ infrastructure\ loans\ to\ school\ districts\ under\ s.$
$44.72~(4)~\underline{(a)}$ and to make full payment of the amounts determined by the building
commission under s. 13.488 (1) (m).".

- **4.** Page 3, line 12: after "received" insert "<u>from public library boards and public</u> library systems".
 - **5.** Page 3, line 15: after "(4)" insert "(am)".
 - **6.** Page 4, line 5: after that line insert:
 - **"Section 8m.** 20.866 (2) (zc) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 20.866 **(2)** (zc) *Technology for educational achievement in Wisconsin board;* school district educational technology infrastructure loans. From the capital improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the technology for educational achievement in Wisconsin board to make subsidized educational technology infrastructure loans to school districts under s. 44.72 (4) (a). The state may contract public debt in an amount not to exceed \$100,000,000 for this purpose.".
 - **7.** Page 4, line 11: after "(4)" insert "(am)".
- **8.** Page 5, line 10: delete lines 10 to 21 and substitute:
- **SECTION 14g.** 44.72 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
 - 44.72 **(4)** (a) *Subsidized loans <u>to school districts</u> authorized.* The board may make subsidized loans under this <u>subsection paragraph</u> to school districts from the proceeds of public debt contracted under s. 20.866 (2) (zc) and to public library boards from the proceeds of public debt contracted under s. 20.866 (2) (zcm). Subsidized

loans under this subsection may be used only for the purpose of upgrading the electrical and computer network wiring of school and library school administration buildings in existence on October 14, 1997, and installing and upgrading computer network wiring. The board may also make subsidized loans under this paragraph to school districts that have completed internal electrical and computer network wiring for the purpose of creating a wide area network for voice, data and video transmission that connects school and school administration buildings in a school district.

Section 14r. 44.72 (4) (am) of the statutes is created to read:

44.72 (4) (am) *Subsidized loans to public libraries authorized.* The board may make subsidized loans under this paragraph to public libraries and public library systems from the proceeds of public debt contracted under s. 20.866 (2) (zcm) for the purpose of upgrading the electrical and computer network wiring of public library and public library system buildings in existence on October 14, 1997. The board may also make subsidized loans under this paragraph to public libraries and public library systems for the purpose of purchasing hardware, other than personal computers, that will enable the computer network in public library and public library system buildings to be directly connected to the internet.".
