Delete lines 11 through 21 on page 5 and change to read as follows:

March 16, 1999

(a) Subsidized loans to school districts authorized. The board may make subsidized loans under this subsection to school districts from the proceeds of public debt contracted under s. 20.866 (2) (zc). Subsidized loans under this subsection may be used for the purpose of upgrading the electrical wiring and computer network wiring in school and school administration buildings in existence on October 14, 1997. The board may also make subsidized loans to school districts which have completed internal electrical and computer network wiring for the purpose of creating a wide area network for voice, data and video transmission that connects school and school administration buildings in a school district. (The board may not exceed the amount of public debt contracted for under s. 20.866 (2) (zc) in making subsidized loans under this (Drugge) subsection.

(b) Subsidized loans to public libraries and public library systems authorized. The board may make subsidized loans under this subsection to public libraries and public library systems from the proceeds of public debt contracted under s. 20.866 (2) (zcm) for the purpose of upgrading the electrical wiring and the computer network wiring in public library and public library system buildings in existence on October 14, 1997. (The board may also make subsidized loans to public libraries and public library systems for the purpose of purchasing hardware excluding personal computers which will enable the computer network in public library and public library system buildings to be directly connected to the internet. The board may not exceed the amount of public debt contracted for under s. 20.866 (2) (zcm) in making subsidized loans under this subsection.

The board may also make subsidized loans under this paragraph to school districts that have completed internal electrical and computer network wiring for the purpose of creating a wide area network for voice, data and video transmission that connects school and school administration buildings in a school district.

SECTION 14r. 44.72 (4) (am) of the statutes is created to read:

44.72 (4) (am) Subsidized loans to public libraries authorized. The board may make subsidized loans under this paragraph to public libraries and public library systems from the proceeds of public debt contracted under s. 20.866 (2) (zcm) for the purpose of upgrading the electrical and computer network wiring of public library and public library system buildings in existence on October 14, 1997. The board may also make subsidized loans under this paragraph to public libraries and public library systems for the purpose of purchasing hardware, other than personal computers, that will enable the computer network in public library and public library system buildings to be directly connected to the internet.".
