1 AN ACT *to create* 157.114 of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring cemetery authorities to provide for burials during each season.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the owner or operator of a cemetery (cemetery authority) to provide for burials, insofar as practicable, during each season, including winter. This requirement does not prohibit a cemetery authority from charging a reasonable fee to recover the costs related to providing for a burial during difficult weather conditions.
