

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill gives the department of veteran affairs (DVA) authority to accept contributions of money on behalf of Wisconsin veterans for the construction of a World War II memorial in Washington, D.C. Under the bill, any contributions received by DVA for the construction of a World War II memorial in Washington, D.C. will be matched by the state, up to \$166,100. The bill requires DVA to submit the contributions plus the state match moneys to the American Battle Monuments Commission by May 15, 2000, for the construction of memorial in Washington, D.C. to honor members of the U.S. armed forces who served in World War II.
