The Department will incur staff and								
the GPR funds. The costs will inclu								
\$15,000 in supplies and services, for a total of \$27,000. The supplies and services will be used for travel expense in meeting with various groups and organizations and for promotional materials to solicit funds. The Department can								
absorb these costs. However, there is a resulting opportunity cost. The Department will not be able to utilize these								
resources to conduct activities related to the Department's mission of helping Wisconsin veterans.								
The fiscal effect of this bill is a one-time increase of spending authority of \$166,100 in GPR and the expenditure of \$27,000 of existing SEG funds for the Department of Veterans Affairs.
