

## 1999 SENATE BILL 87

March 18, 1999 – Introduced by Senators RISSER, BURKE, COWLES, ROSENZWEIG and RUDE, cosponsored by Representatives URBAN, J. LEHMAN, MILLER, HANDRICK, KELSO, BERCEAU, RYBA and POWERS. Referred to Committee on Human Services and Aging.

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 346.79 (6) and 346.82 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** the use  
2           of bicycle helmets and providing a penalty.

### ***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires that whenever a person younger than 18 years of age (minor) is riding a bicycle upon a highway, bicycle lane or bicycle way, the person wear an approved bicycle helmet properly fastened to his or her head. The bill also:

1. Prohibits parents and guardians of minors from knowingly permitting a minor to ride or be a passenger on a bicycle without properly wearing an approved bicycle helmet.

2. Prohibits any person from renting or leasing a bicycle for the use of a minor unless the minor is in possession of an approved bicycle helmet.

3. Prohibits any person from selling a bicycle for the use of a minor without first ascertaining that the minor owns an approved bicycle helmet.

A violator may be required to forfeit not more than \$30, except that no forfeiture may be assessed against a parent, guardian or minor if the parent, guardian or minor provides proof that, within 30 days after the citation was issued, he or she obtained a helmet for his or her regular use.
