(Last Session's AB 870)

Jim would like to have this bill drafted. It should read the same as 1997 Assembly Bill 870, with the below addition. *+ a few words added to the old bill.*

“No baiting from the Monday before the deer/gun season through the Friday after the deer/gun season ends. No wildlife feeding more than 100 feet away from a residence without a free wildlife permit for non-hunting feeders”.

*feeding permit*

*do not include muzzle loading*

## 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 870

March 2, 1998 - Introduced by Representative BAUMGART, by request of Donald Lohr of Sheboygan. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources.

1 **AN ACT to create** 29.235 of the statutes; **relating to:** using bait to hunt deer.

---

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current rules promulgated by the department of natural resources restrict the types and locations of bait that can be placed for the hunting of wild animals. This bill prohibits the placement of any bait for the purpose of hunting deer during any season that is open to the hunting of deer with firearms.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 29.235 of the statutes is created to read:

3 **29.235 Hunting deer with bait prohibited.** No person may place bait for  
4 the purpose of hunting deer during any season open to hunting of deer with firearms.

1 AN ACT <sup>Van Cat.</sup> relating to: attracting wild animals with bait and granting  
2 rule-making authority.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current rules promulgated by the department of natural resources (DNR) restrict the types and locations of bait that may be placed for the hunting of certain wild animals. This bill prohibits the use of bait for the purpose of hunting deer during the period beginning on the Monday immediately before the first day of regular gun deer season and ending on the Friday immediately following the last day of regular gun deer season.

This bill also prohibits a person from using bait to attract wild animals more than 100 yards from a residence for a purpose other than hunting unless the person has a permit issued by DNR. The bill requires DNR to establish requirements and procedures for issuing these permits and prohibits DNR from charging a fee for these permits.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 SECTION 1. 29.335 of the statutes is created to read:

1           **29.335 Use of bait.** (1) DEFINITION. In this section, "regular gun deer season"  
 2 means the deer hunting season established by the department that begins in  
 3 November and that authorizes hunting <sup>with</sup> ~~by~~ firearms other than muzzleloaders.

4           (2) BAIT FOR HUNTING DEER. No person may place or use bait for the purpose of  
 5 hunting deer during the period beginning on the Monday immediately before the  
 6 first day of regular gun deer <sup>e</sup> season and ending on the Friday immediately following  
 7 the last day of the regular gun deer <sup>e</sup> season.

8           (3) BAIT FOR NONHUNTING PURPOSES. (a) No person may place or use bait more  
 9 than 100 yards from a residence to attract wild animals for purposes other than  
 10 hunting unless the person holds a permit issued by the department under par. (b).

11           (b) The department shall promulgate rules to establish requirements and  
 12 procedures for issuing permits that authorize the placement or use of bait more than  
 13 100 yards from residences to attract wild animals for purposes other than hunting.  
 14 The department may not charge a fee for these permits.



If the analysis indicates that a fiscal estimate is required because the proposal makes an appropriation or increases or decreases existing appropriations or state or general local government fiscal liability or revenues, you have the option to request the fiscal estimate prior to introduction. If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
