Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits any person from duplicating, by any means whatever, a driver's license. Penalties for a violation range from a mandatory minimum forfeiture of \$200 for a first offense, up to a maximum penalty of a \$2,000 fine and imprisonment for ~~3~~ months for a ~~first~~ or subsequent offense within ~~3~~ years.

This bill creates an exception to this prohibition. The bill allows ~~motor vehicle dealers~~ ^{licensed motor vehicle dealers} to reproduce a copy of a driver's license if the reproduction is done according to rules promulgated by the department of transportation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 343.43 (1) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.43 (1) (f) Reproduce by any means whatever a copy of a license, unless the person is a motor vehicle dealer licensed under ch. 218 and ~~the~~ reproduction is done pursuant to rules promulgated by the department; or
