1997 SENATE BILL 15

January 15, 1997 – Introduced by Senators Breske, Decker, Clausing, Grobschmidt and Zien, cosponsored by Representatives Handrick, Ryba, Springer, Ourada, Grothman, Vrakas, Turner, Zukowski, Boyle, Kreuser, Seratti and Powers. Referred to Committee on Agriculture and Environmental Resources.

AN ACT to amend 29.104 (4) (a) (intro.); and to create 29.104 (4) (am) of the statutes; relating to: issuing crossbow hunting permits to persons who are physically unable to use a bow and arrow.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person may receive a permit from the department of natural resources to hunt with a crossbow if the person has suffered a disability affecting certain upper extremities, such as a become or certain fingers, and if the person is unable to use a bow and arrow. If the disability involves a permanent substantial loss of function in one or both hands, arms or shoulders, a crossbow permit may not be issued unless the person fails certain strength tests. Under current law, a licensed physician or chiropractor must administer these upper extremity strength tests. Under this bill, sperson is also eligible for a crossbow permit if a licensed physician or chiropractor certifies in writing that the person is physically unable to hunt with a bow and arrow.

29.171 (4) (c) The department may issue a crossbow permit to an applicant who is ineligible for a permit under par. (a) or who is denied a permit under par. (a) if, upon review and after considering the physical condition of the applicant and the recommendation of a licensed physician or licensed chiropractor selected by the applicant from a list of licensed physicians and licensed chiropractors compiled by the department, the department finds that issuance of a permit complies with the intent of this subsection. The use of this review procedure is discretionary with the department and all costs of the review procedure shall be paid by the applicant.
