1 AN ACT to ~~create~~ 63.275 of the statutes; relating to: the eligibility of certain
2 employees of 1st class cities to take general promotional examinations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill specifically authorizes, for 1st class cities (presently only Milwaukee), certain members of the fire and police departments, and certain employees of first class cities who are not members of the classified service, to take general promotional examinations that are given by or for the city service commission if these persons are otherwise qualified to take such examinations. The bill does not apply to officers who are elected by the people, one deputy in each department whose office was created by statute, heads of principal departments of the city and certain appointees of the mayor.

For further information see the *local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 63.275 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **63.275 General promotional examinations.** (1) Except as provided in sub.

5 (2), all members of the fire and police departments and all city employes who are not

2 commissioners under s. 63.27 are eligible to take any general promotional
3 examination that is given or administered by, or conducted for, the city service
4 commission if such persons are otherwise qualified to take such an examination.



If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
