939.63 (2) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** committing certain crimes while possessing, using or threatening to use a firearm and providing penalties.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person who commits a felony while possessing, using or threatening to use a dangerous weapon is subject, upon conviction, to a three—year minimum sentence for the first violation and a five—year minimum sentence for any subsequent violation. The terms are presumptive minimum terms because the court may give a lesser sentence or probation if it states its reasons for doing so on the record.

This bill narrows the coverage of the law, shortens the minimum terms and makes the terms mandatory. Under the bill, if a person commits a specified violent or drug—related felony while possessing, using or threatening to use a firearm, the person is subject, upon conviction, to a one—year mandatory minimum sentence for the first violation and a three—year mandatory minimum sentence for any subsequent violation. The court must sentence the person to at least the applicable minimum sentence and may not place the person on probation.

For further information see the **state and local** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

939.63 (2) (a) 1. Whoever If a person is convicted of committing a felony covered under subd. 2. while possessing, using or threatening to use a dangerous weapon shall be sentenced to a minimum term of years in prison, unless the sentencing court otherwise provides. The minimum term for the first application of this subsection is 3 years. The minimum term for any subsequent application of this subsection is 5 years. If the court places the person on probation or imposes a sentence less than the presumptive minimum sentence, it shall place its reasons for so doing on the record firearm, the court shall sentence the person to not less than one year of imprisonment for the first application of this subdivision and to not less than 3 years of imprisonment for any subsequent application of this subdivision. The court may not place the person on probation.
