At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

1. Page 1 , line 8 : after that line insert:
"Section 1m. 146.83 (1) (b) of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:
146.83 (1) (b) Receive a copy of the patient's heal th care records upon payment of reasonable costs.".
2. Page 2 , line 2 : after that line insert:
"Section 2m. 146.83 (1) (c) of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:
146.83 (1) (c) Receive a copy of the health care provider's X-ray reports or have the X-rays referred to another health care provider of the patient's choice upon payment of reasonable costs.".
3. Page 2 , line 11 : after that line insert:
"Section 3m. 146.83 (3m) of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), is repealed.".
4. Page 3, line 9: after that line insert:
"Section 5m. 908.03 ( 6 m ) (d) of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), sections 4 and 5 , is repealed and recreated to read:
908.03 ( 6 m ) (d) Fees. The department of health and family services shall, by rule, prescribe uniform fees based on an approximation of the actual costs that a health care provider may charge under par. (c) 3 . for certified duplicate health care records. The rule shall also allow the health care provider to charge for postage or other delivery costs.".
5. Page 3 , line 19: after that line insert:
"(2) Fees for patient health care records. The repeal of section 146.83 (3m) of the statutes and the repeal and recreation of sections 146.83 (1) (b) and (c) and $908.03(6 \mathrm{~m})$ (d) of the statutes take effect on the first day of the 37th month beginning after publication.".
