Under the substitute amendment, the child care career education scholarship program is funded by federal temporary assistance to needy families (TANF) dollars. The fiscal estimate prepared by DWD for 1999 SB199, however, indicates that federal funding under TANF is sum certain and that, as such, the funding needed for the scholarship program would have to come from GPR or from reallocating other TANF expenditures. You might want to talk to Bob Nikolay at DWD (6-9475), who prepared the fiscal estimate, about how TANF spending might be reallocated to fund the scholarship program or, if that does not seem feasible, appropriating new GPR to fund the scholarship program.
