1 AN ACT to create 77.54 (44) of the statutes; relating to: exempting sales of

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United States flags and state flags from the sales tax and the use tax.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales and use tax exemption for the United States flag and the state flag.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 77.54 (44) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 77.54 **(44)** The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use or other

5 consumption of the United States flag or the state flag. This subsection does not

6 apply to a representation of the United States flag or the state flag.

7 SECTION 2. Effective date.

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1 (1) This act takes effect on first day of the 2nd month beginning after 2 publication.
