AN ACT ...; relating to: inducing or causing self-mutilation by a child and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do

enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 939.50 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

939.50 (1) (intro.) Except as provided in ss. 948.035 (1), 946.83 and 946.85,

felonies in chs. 939 to 951 are classified as follows:

SECTION 2. 939.66 (8) of the statutes is created to read:

939.66 (8) The crime specified in s. 948.035 (1) when the crime charged is

Section 3. 948.035 of the statutes is created to read:

10 948.035 Causing mutilation of a child. Whoever induces or causes a child

to intentionally cut his or her own skin may be penalized as follows:

1	(1) If the child suffers substantial bodily harm as a result, the person may be
2	imprisoned for not more than 2 years or fined not more than \$10,000 or both.
3	(2) If the child suffers great bodily harm as a result, the person is guilty of a
4	Class E felony.
