1 AN ACT *to create* 196.637 of the statutes; **relating to:** deferred payment 2 agreements between public utilities and customers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, if a public utility and a customer make a deferred payment agreement regarding a delinquent account, the public utility may not report the delinquency to a credit reporting agency unless the customer fails to comply with the agreement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 196.637 of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 **196.637 Deferred payment agreements.** If a public utility and a customer
- 5 enter into a deferred payment agreement regarding a delinquent account, the public
- 6 utility may not report the delinquency to a credit reporting agency unless the
- 7 customer fails to comply with agreement.
