- 1 AN ACT *to amend* 347.50 (1); and *to create* 347.50 (4m) of the statutes; **relating**
- **to:** mufflers on motorcycles and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person who operates a motorcycle without a functioning muffler may be required to pay a forfeiture of not less than \$10 nor more than \$200. This bill raises the forfeiture for operating a motorcycle without a functioning muffler to not less than \$100 nor more than \$300.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 347.50 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 347.50 **(1)** Any person violating ss. 347.35 to 347.49, except s. 347.413 (1) or s.
- 5 347.415 (1), (2) and (3) to (5) or s. 347.417 (1) or s. 347.48 (2m) or (4) (a) or s. 347.486
- 6 (3) or s. 347.489, may be required to forfeit not less than \$10 nor more than \$200.
- **SECTION 2.** 347.50 (4m) of the statutes is created to read:
- 8 347.50 **(4m)** Any person violating s. 347.486 (3) may be required to forfeit not
- 9 less than \$100 nor more than \$300.
