Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person may not advertise an auction that is conducted by a person who is registered as a auctioneer by the department of regulation and licensing (DORL) unless the advertisement includes a statement that the auctioneer is a "registered Wisconsin auctioneer". This bill allows DORL to promulgate rules that allow a person to abbreviate "registered Wisconsin auctioneer" for purposes of the statement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 480.06 (6) of the statutes is created to read:
- 5 480.06 **(6)** The department may promulgate rules that allow a person to
- 6 abbreviate "registered Wisconsin auctioneer" for purposes of a statement required
- 7 under s. 480.20 (2).
