## 1995 SENATE BILL 412

November 9, 1995 - Introduced by Senators DECKER and BRESKE, cosponsored by Representatives MUSSER, BALDUS and KREUSER. Referred to Committee on Environment and Energy.

1 AN ACT *to create* 29.245 (4) (b) 3. and 29.245 (5) (b) 4m. of the statutes; relating  
2 to: shining rough fish while fishing with a bow or a crossbow.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, the shining of most wild animals is prohibited with certain exceptions. This bill allows the shining of rough fish by a person who is fishing for rough fish with a bow or a crossbow.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 SECTION 1. 29.245 (4) (b) 3. of the statutes is created to read:

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

are Under current law, the shining of most wild animals is prohibited with certain exceptions. One of those exceptions provides that the prohibition does not apply to a person who possesses or uses a light while using a bow and arrow for taking rough fish on lakes that not outlying waters. Under this bill, this exception applies to the taking of rough fish on any waters of this state.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 1. 29.314 (4) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

3 29.314 (4) (b) 3. To a person who possesses or uses a light while using a bow  
4 and arrow for taking rough fish on lakes that are not outlying waters ✓ any waters of  
5 this state.
