## **1999 SENATE BILL 234**

September 16, 1999 – Introduced by Senators Risser and Darling, cosponsored by Representatives Travis, Urban, Lassa, Carpenter, La Fave, J. Lehman, Turner, Young, Sinicki, Bock and Berceau. Referred to Committee on Judiciary and Consumer Affairs.

- AN ACT *to repeal* 948.55 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** leaving or storing a
- 2 loaded firearm within the reach or easy access of a child.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides various penalties for recklessly storing or leaving a loaded firearm within the reach or easy access of a child who is younger than 14 years old. This bill broadens the coverage of that law so that it applies to leaving a loaded firearm within the reach or easy access of a child who is younger than 18 years old.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 948.55 (1) of the statutes is repealed.
- 4 Section 2. Initial applicability.
- 5 (1) This act first applies to offenses occurring on the effective date of this subsection.
