AN ACT to repeal 948.55 (1) of the statutes; relating to: leaving or storing a

loaded firearm within the reach or easy access of a child.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides various penalties for recklessly storing or leaving a loaded firearm within the reach or easy access of a child who is younger than 14 years old. This bill broadens the coverage of that law so that it applies to leaving a loaded firearm within the reach or easy access of a child who is younger than 18 years old.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- SECTION 1. 948.55 (1) of the statutes is repealed.
- 4 Section 2. Initial applicability.
- 5 (1) This act first applies to offenses occurring on the effective date of this subsection.
