**HEALTH AND FAMILY SERVICES****Elderly Nutrition Programs****Motion:**

Move to provide \$1,075,000 GPR annually to distribute to the area agencies on aging to fund elderly nutrition programs as follows: (a) \$600,000 GPR annually for home delivered meals; and (b) \$475,000 GPR annually for congregate meals.

---

**Note:**

DHFS distributes state and federal funding for elderly nutrition programs to area agencies on agencies which, in turn, allocate funds to counties or tribes based on a formula. Home-delivered meals and congregate meals are provided to persons age 60 or older and some non-elderly individuals with disabilities. In addition to providing meals, funding for elderly nutrition programs is also used to provide outreach, nutrition education, information and referrals and other supportive services, such as dietary counseling and transportation.

Federal funding is available under the Older Americans Act. It is estimated that in 1998-99, DHFS will distribute \$13,000,600 (\$5,463,700 GPR and \$7,536,900 FED) for congregate meals and \$2,229,200 FED for home-delivered meals. In addition to the funding distributed to the area agencies on aging, the U.S. Department of Agriculture provides cash reimbursement of 0.58578¢ per meal for home-delivered meals.

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

Under current federal law, this state receives federal moneys to maintain congregate nutrition projects that provide meals to persons aged 60 and older. Under current state law, the department of health and family services (DHFS) must provide a state supplement of general purpose revenues to the federal congregate nutrition projects to enable expansion of these projects throughout this state. DHFS distributes these moneys to area agencies on aging in the state under formulas that DHFS has developed.

This bill increases an appropriation of general purpose revenues in DHFS by a total of \$1,075,000 in each of state fiscal years 1999-2000 and 2000-01 to increase the state supplement to federal moneys received for congregate nutrition projects. Of the amounts proposed to be appropriated, \$600,000 is proposed in each of the fiscal years for congregate meals and \$475,000 is proposed in each of the fiscal years for home-delivered meals.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
