

<b>Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate</b>  <p><b>This bill creates a penalty if a person buys or accepts transfer of ownership of a handgun when he or she does not have a fingerprint record on file with the department of justice. This simply adds one more requirement onto current handgun transfer requirements which continue under this bill. These include requirements that would likely also be violated at the same time as the fingerprint requirement was violated. Thus it is likely that this bill would have a nugatory impact on the workload of district attorneys' offices.</b></p>
