If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.

1 AN ACT to amend 15.405 (5g) of the statutes; relating to: membership of the  
2 controlled substances board.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, the controlled substances board consists of one psychiatrist, one pharmacologist and the following persons or their designees: the attorney general; the secretary of health and family services; the secretary of agriculture, trade and consumer protection; and the chairperson of the pharmacy examining board. Under this bill, the chairpersons of the board of nursing and the medical examining board, or their designees, are also members of the board.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 SECTION 1. 15.405 (5g) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4 15.405 (5g) CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES BOARD. There is created in the department  
5 of regulation and licensing a controlled substances board consisting of the attorney  
6 general, the secretary of health and family services and the secretary of agriculture,
