Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate


This bill imposes new duties on the Department of Regulation and Licensing. This bill requires the department to register certain individuals as wetland scientists. These persons must notify the department if their certification, registration or accreditation is revoked by a national organization so the department can revoke their registration in the State of Wisconsin.

The department would license approximately 150 registrants during the current biennium. Costs associated with these licensures would include printing of applications and brochures (\$1,500), postage (\$600), phone costs (\$2,000), and other supplies and services (\$2,500).

The revenues estimates are the total cost needed to implement the duties outlined in the bill. These costs would be passed along to credential holders who registered as a wetland scientist.
