the ECB to organize and maintain a nonprofit corporation for the exclusive purpose of raising funds to support the ECB's activities. In addition, the ECB may contract with such a corporation for providing administrative services to the corporation. Current law prohibits the corporation from employing staff. In addition, current law requires that, if the corporation acquires any real property, the corporation must donate the property to the state within five years after acquiring the property, unless holding the property for more than five years is approved by the joint committee on finance.

This bill allows the ECB to organize and maintain a nonprofit corporation for any public broadcasting purpose. In addition, the bill allows the ECB to contract with such a corporation to provide any services to the corporation, not just the administrative services that are allowed under current law. The bill also repeals the prohibition against the corporation's employment of staff and repeals the requirement for the corporation to donate any real property that it acquires to the state. Under the bill, the employes of the nonprofit corporation are covered under the WRS. As participating employes under the WRS, the employes are eligible for insurance benefits provided to state employes who are participating employes under the WRS.

In addition, the bill increases the general fund supported bonding authority of the building commission by the following amounts: (\$13,20,800) for a digital television conversion project for the ECB; (\$1,00,000) for a digital television conversion project for the University William System; and \$3,500,000 for a digital conversion project for the Milwaukee Area Technical College. The bill enumerates the authorization of these projects in the 1999–2001 authorized state building program.

Finally, the bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for equipment used for transmitting a digital radio or television signal or used for producing programming that is transmitted through such a signal.
