Rick:

I may have given you the incorrect LRB # on my voice message. We want to draft an amendment to the mini budget that will keep *current* law that sends the PILT payment to schools, but that will provide a one time GPR appropriation of \$1,805,800 to towns under the same distribution scheme as the old PILT formula. The intent of this provision would be to hold the Towns harmless for one year until the increased federal payment for having shifted from towns to schools comes in.

Vaughn --

In SB 357 (the Sen. Dem. mini-budget), there already is a provision restoring prior law. See ss. 20.370 (5) (bx) and 59.25 (3) (rm). You have asked me to draft 99-4417 as an amendment to SB 357. Do you want me also to delete the restoration of prior law and simply provide the one-time payment of \$1,805,800 or do you wish for me to keep the restoration of the old law and provide for the one-time payment. If you choose the latter option, towns could very likely receive a double payment of these national forest moneys. You may wish to speak with Russ Kava about the flow of money.

PAYMENTS TO CERTAIN TOWNS.

No later than October 1, 2000, the secretary of natural resources shall distribute \$1,500,000 from the appropriation account under section 20.370 (5) (dd)

of the statutes, as created by this act, to towns that were eligible to receive national forest income payments under section 59.25 (3) (r), 1997 stats., during the 1998-99 fiscal year. The secretary shall distribute the moneys to the towns according to the criteria required for the distribution of national forest income payments under section 59.25 (3) (r), 1997 stats.

SECTION 5. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after publication,

except as follows:

The repeal of section 20.370 (5) (dd) of the statutes takes effect on December 31, 2000.
