

## 1999 SENATE BILL 364

February 3, 2000 – Introduced by Senators MOEN, BURKE, MOORE and PLACHE, cosponsored by Representatives DUFF, GARD, PORTER, WARD, KAUFERT and ALBERS. Referred to Health, Utilities, Veterans and Military Affairs.

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 231.03 (6) (intro.) and 231.08 (1); and *to create* 231.08 (7) of  
2           the statutes; **relating to:** bonding authority of the Wisconsin health and  
3           educational facilities authority.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, the Wisconsin health and educational facilities authority (WHEFA) is authorized to issue bonds to finance the acquisition, construction, enlargement, remodeling, renovation, improvement, furnishing and equipping of any health facility, educational facility or child care center. This bill prohibits WHEFA from issuing bonds to purchase a health maintenance organization or any other insurer.

5           231.03 **(6)** (intro.) Issue Subject to s. 231.08 (7), issue bonds of the authority,
