SUBJECT: Science World

At your request, I am providing information on the Science World program. Specifically, you asked for information regarding funding for the program.

Science World is a summer science enrichment program sponsored by DPI and held at the Pigeon Lake Field Station near Drummond, Wisconsin. The program consists of four one-week sessions for eighth grade pupils and four concurrent one-week professional development sessions for K-12 teachers of all grade levels. In 1998-99, the per pupil registration fee for the program was \$225. In 1998-99, DPI allocated a total of approximately \$225,600 for Science World (\$168,000 FED and \$57,600 PR derived from the pupil registration fee). There is no separate appropriation for Science World; instead, DPI has allocated federal funding for the program.

While a final decision has not been made, staff from DPI have indicated that federal funding for the program may be reallocated to other professional development initiatives. Staff note two reasons for possibly discontinuing the program. First, the number of participants has declined in recent years. Second, federal regulations governing use of the funding allocated for the program have been modified to allow DPI to use the funding for professional development activities in all subject areas rather than in just science and math, therefore, DPI may consider using the funding for professional development activities in other subject areas.
