Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of natural resources (DNR) administers a dam safety program that is funded by state bonding and that provides matching grants to municipalities and public inland lake protection and rehabilitation districts for the purpose of conducting dam safety projects that DNR has determined need to be done.

Under this bill, DNR must provide up to \$250,000 in funding from general purpose revenues to the village of Cazenovia for the repair of a dam located in the village. If the repairs cost less than \$250,000, the remaining amount must be used by DNR for projects under the dam safety program.





Upon review, it appears that the drafts are in need of technical changes regarding the location of the dam itself, and as Mary Gibson-Glass is now on vacation in Mexico, would you you (or other appropriate member of the LRB staff) be able to make the necessary changes?

31.308 Dam in village of Cazenovia. The department shall provide to the village of Cazenovia the amount necessary for a dam safety project to repair a dam that is located in the portion of the village that is in ~~Stout~~ ^{Richland} County, but the amount provided may not exceed \$250,000. If the amount provided to the village of Cazenovia is less than \$250,000, the department shall use the remaining amount as financial assistance under the financial assistance program for dam safety projects under s. 31.385.

SECTION 4. 31.385 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

31.385 (2) (d) The financial assistance shall be paid from the appropriations under ~~ss.~~ ss. 20.370 (5) (ae) and 20.866 (2) (tL) and (tx), except as provided in 1991 Wisconsin Act 39, section 9142 (10d).
