All costs associated with out-of-state forest fire fighting efforts are reimbursed to the State of Wisconsin.

- \* Reimbursements for base salary and fringe are deposited to the Forest Fire Emergency appropriations until the cap for the appropriations has been reached. Once the cap is reached the residual reimbursements for base salary and fringe are deposited to the Forestry Account.
- \* Reimbursements for all overtime costs are deposited to the Forestry Account.
- \* Reimbursements for operational costs (supplies and services) are allotted back to the expense budgets from which the expenses were paid.
- \* Reimbursements for administrative service costs are deposited to the Department's indirect appropriation.
