- 1 AN ACT *to amend* 15.91 of the statutes; **relating to:** appointment of students
- 2 to the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides that the governor must appoint one student member to the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System and that the governor may select this student member from recommendations made by elected representatives of student governments at institutions within the UW System. This bill requires the governor to appoint two student members, one of whom may be selected from these recommendations and the other of whom must be selected from these recommendations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 15.91 of the statutes is amended to read:
