Under current law, a participant in the community service job or transitional placement wind when categories inder the Wisconsin works (W-2) program may participate in a technical college education program as part of community service job or transitional placement if a W-2 agency, after consulting with a community steering committee and a technical college district board, determines that the technical college education program is likely to lead to employment, and the participant is a full-time student in the technical college education program, maintains a 2.0 grade point average and works or is employed in a community service job or transitional placement for 25 hours per week.

This bill permits a participant in a community service job or transitional placement to elect to participate in a technical college education program. Whis bill eliminates the requirement that the participant work or be employed in acommunity service job or transitional placement for 25 hours per week of whom this bill

continues to

For every hour that the participant misses work or other required activities without good cause, the grant amount shall be reduced by \$5.15. Good cause shall be determined by the financial and employment planner in accordance with rules promulgated by the department. Good cause shall include required court appearances for a victim of domestic abuse.

SECTION 5. 49.148 (1) (c) of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, is amended to read:

49.148 (1) (c) Transitional placements. For a participant in a transitional placement under s. 49.147 (5) or in a transitional placement and in self-initiated technical college education under s. 49.147 (5m), a grant of \$628, paid monthly by the Wisconsin works agency. For every hour that the participant fails to participate in any required activity without good cause, including any activity under s. 49.147 (5) (b) 1. a. to e., the grant amount shall be reduced by \$5.15. Good cause shall be determined by the financial and employment planner in accordance with rules promulgated by the department. Good cause shall include required court appearances for a victim of domestic abuse.
