Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate							
Under current law an individual who is enrolled in the Wisconsin Conservation Corps (WCC) for six months to one year is entitled to an education voucher of not more than \$2,800 to pay for tuition and fees to attend an institution of higher education (college). The voucher is valid for up to three years from the date of issue.							
SB 490 extends the validity period for a tuition voucher from three to six years, and, an enrollee is permitted to request from the WCC board annual extensions of a voucher beyond the six year period, one year at a time. The bill also allows a WCC enrollee to use the voucher for payment of tuition and fees for private trade, business, correspondence or technical school that has been approved by the states educational approval board.							
It is anticipated that the extension of the validity period from three to six years will not substantially increase the number of vouchers issued. Most enrollees that are interested in a tuition voucher use it earlier rather than later. However, an increase in expenditure of approximately 5% is anticipated because the bill broadens, increases the choices, of the types of schools an enrollee could attend, i.e., private trade, business, correspondence or technical schools.							
Currently, about 60 - 65 vouchers are issued annually. At \$2,800/voucher the cost is approximately \$168,000 - \$182,000/year. Assuming that the total number of vouchers will increase by 5%, the estimated expenditure increase would be approximately \$8,400 annually.
