Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of justice distributes grants to law enforcement agencies in cities with high levels of violent and drug-related crime, to enable them to acquire innovative law enforcement technology. A law enforcement agency receiving a grant under this program must provide matching funds equal to 50% of the grant awarded. This bill establishes a separate grant program under which the office of justice assistance (OJA) provides grants to state and local law enforcement agencies, to enable them to acquire innovative police technology and to train law enforcement officers and agency employees in the use of the technology. The bill does not require OJA to consider crime levels in the jurisdictions served by agencies seeking grants, nor does it require any matching funds from agencies receiving grants.



If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
