

appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of justice distributes grants to law enforcement agencies in cities with high levels of violent and drug—related crime to enable them to acquire innovative law enforcement technology. A law enforcement agency receiving a grant under this program must provide matching funds equal to 50% of the grant awarded. This bill establishes a separate grant program under which the office of justice assistance (OJA) provides grants to state and local law enforcement agencies to enable them to acquire innovative police technology and to train law enforcement officers and agency employes in the use of the technology. The bill does not require OJA to consider crime levels in the jurisdictions served by agencies seeking grants, nor does it require any matching funds from agencies receiving grants.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
