The proposed legislation exempts from income taxation any interest on bonds that a county may issue for purposes related to the construction and renovation of football stadium facilities.						
The revenue effect would depend on the size of the bond offering, the interest rate on the bonds, the amounts of bonds held by individuals subject to Wisconsin tax and the tax rates imposed on these bond holders (rates on individuals range from 4.6% to 6.75% beginning in tax year 2001). Assuming an issue of \$160 million, an annual interest rate of 6.25% and an average marginal tax rate of 6.5%, the first year revenue loss if all bonds were issued and held by individuals subject to Wisconsin						
income tax would be about \$650,000 (\$160 million X .0625 X 0.065). With an issue totaling \$160 million, a 6.25% interest rate and a 30-year repayment period, the total revenue loss over the repayment period would be about \$12.7 million, assuming that the bonds are maturing as serial bonds.
