<b>Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate</b> Among other things, this bill requires that the Legislative Reference Bureau (LRB) provide copies of each ward plan to the elections board, which will incur some minimal cost. However, we believe that cost can be absorbed within our budget. The bill does not otherwise appear to increase appreciably the LRB's role in redistricting plans.
