

1999 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 10

February 25, 1999 – Introduced by Senators CLAUSING, MOEN, BURKE, COWLES, ERPENBACH, FARROW, RUDE and SCHULTZ, cosponsored by Representatives RHOADES, PLOUFF, ALBERS, BRANDEMUEHL, COLON, FREESE, GRONEMUS, HUEBSCH, KESTELL, KLUSMAN, KREIBICH, LADWIG, MILLER, OLSEN, POCAN, REYNOLDS, RYBA, SERATTI, SHERMAN, SPILLNER, SUDER, SYKORA and VRAKAS. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** commending the University of Wisconsin–River Falls for its
2 contributions to the quality of life in Wisconsin over the past 125 years.

3 Whereas, in 1874 a State Normal School was established in River Falls to train
4 teachers for northwestern Wisconsin, making the school the fifth public higher
5 education institution in the new State of Wisconsin; and

6 Whereas, through the past 125 years, the University of Wisconsin–River Falls
7 has taken tremendous strides as a comprehensive institution of higher learning to
8 expand its educational offerings to more than 40 undergraduate and graduate
9 programs in education, the sciences, humanities, liberal arts, business and
10 agriculture; and

11 Whereas, its student body has expanded from a few hundred men and women
12 attending classes in a single building to a population now numbering more than
13 5,600 persons on a campus of 25 buildings; and
