1999 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION



1 **To renumber and amend** section 12 of article VII; and **to create** section 12 (2) of
2 article VII of the constitution; **relating to:** 4-year terms of office for clerks of
3 the circuit courts (first consideration).

the assembly (B)

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This proposed constitutional amendment, proposed to the 1999 legislature on first consideration, extends the terms of office of clerks of the circuit courts from two years to four years. The change first applies to the clerks of circuit court who are elected at the first general election at which the governor is elected which occurs after the ratification of this amendment.

A proposed constitutional amendment requires adoption by 2 successive legislatures, and ratification by the people, before it can become effective.

4 **Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 12 of article VII of the constitution is renumbered section
6 12 (1) of article VII and amended to read:

7 [Article VII] Section 12 (1) There Except as provided in sub. (2), there shall be
8 a clerk of the circuit court chosen in each county organized for judicial purposes by
9 the qualified electors thereof, who shall hold his office for two years, subject to

1 removal as shall be provided by law; in case of a vacancy, the judge of the circuit court
2 shall have power to appoint a clerk until the vacancy shall be filled by an election;
3 the clerk thus elected or appointed shall give such security as the legislature may
4 require. The supreme court shall appoint its own clerk, and a clerk of the circuit court
5 may be appointed a clerk of the supreme court.

6 **SECTION 2.** Section 12 (2) of article VII of the constitution is created to read:

7 [Article VII] Section 12 (2) Beginning with the first general election at which
8 the governor is elected which occurs after the ratification of this subsection, clerks
9 of circuit court shall hold office for 4 years.

10 ***Be it further resolved, That*** this proposed amendment be referred to the
11 legislature to be chosen at the next general election and that it be published for 3
12 months previous to the time of holding such election.
