Relating to: increasing public awareness and attention to Chronic Fatigue Syndrome as a serious and complex illness that affects many Wisconsin citizens.

Whereas, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimates that Chronic Fatigue Syndrome affects 238 adults per 100,000 population and 58 adolescents per 100,000 population in the United States; and

Whereas, Chronic Fatigue Syndrome affects all racial, ethnic, and age groups of both sexes; and

Whereas, Chronic Fatigue Syndrome is characterized by incapacitating exhaustion which continues for at least six months and is accompanied by a variety of symptoms such as muscle pain, exercise intolerance, headaches, sleep disorders, neurological problems, and substantial impairment in short-term memory or concentration; and

Whereas, the cause of Chronic Fatigue Syndrome is unknown, despite ongoing research supported by the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) and CDC; and

Whereas, the medical profession has not identified an effective treatment for Chronic Fatigue Syndrome; and

Whereas, many Wisconsin citizens with Chronic Fatigue Syndrome struggle to cope with this illness on a daily basis without full understanding and support from the general public and the medical community; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, that Chronic Fatigue Syndrome is recognized as a serious public health concern that requires attention and understanding from health professionals and the general public.

Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
