November 4, 1999 – Introduced by Senators CHVALA and RISSER.

Relating to: creating a committee of conference on 1999 Assembly Bill 465 and 1999
Senate Bill 237, relating to: classification and elements of felony offenses and
certain misdemeanor offenses; modification of a bifurcated sentence in certain
cases; revocation of extended supervision; the creation of a sentencing
commission and temporary sentencing guidelines; making an appropriation;
and providing penalties.

7 *Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That*, upon the adoption 8 of this joint resolution by the senate and concurrence therein by the assembly and 9 notwithstanding joint rule 3, there is created a committee of conference on 1999 10 Assembly Bill 465 and 1999 Senate Bill 237, the 1999 "Truth in Sentencing Bills", 11 to reconcile the differences between the 2 houses, as reflected by 1999 Assembly Bill 12 465, as engrossed by the assembly, and Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to 1999 13 Assembly Bill 465 and Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to 1999 Senate Bill 237, and 14 to present its report on either or both of the bills to the 2 houses; and, be it further

Resolved, That, notwithstanding joint rule 3, senate rule 35 and assembly
rule 40 (1), neither bill need receive 3 readings.
