

1999 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 26

November 4, 1999 – Introduced by Senators CHVALA and RISSER.

1 **Relating to:** creating a committee of conference on 1999 Assembly Bill 465 and 1999
2 Senate Bill 237, relating to: classification and elements of felony offenses and
3 certain misdemeanor offenses; modification of a bifurcated sentence in certain
4 cases; revocation of extended supervision; the creation of a sentencing
5 commission and temporary sentencing guidelines; making an appropriation;
6 and providing penalties.

7 *Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That,* upon the adoption
8 of this joint resolution by the senate and concurrence therein by the assembly and
9 notwithstanding joint rule 3, there is created a committee of conference on 1999
10 Assembly Bill 465 and 1999 Senate Bill 237, the 1999 “Truth in Sentencing Bills”,
11 to reconcile the differences between the 2 houses, as reflected by 1999 Assembly Bill
12 465, as engrossed by the assembly, and Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to 1999
13 Assembly Bill 465 and Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to 1999 Senate Bill 237, and
14 to present its report on either or both of the bills to the 2 houses; and, be it further
