**Robert W. Dean**



Robert W. Dean, 66, died Thursday morning, Dec. 2, 1999, at Rock Haven. Mr. Dean was born on July 20, 1923, in Tomahawk, Wis., the sixth child of seven of Elmer E. and Anna (Hain) Dean. He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1942 until 1946. He received a football scholarship to the University of Wisconsin from 1941 to 1942, where he played on the University football team. Robert graduated from the University of Wisconsin Law School with an LL.B. degree. He married Kay Hansen of Stevens Point in 1947 and later married Lois Milane of Wausau in 1981. She preceded him in death in 1989. From 1951 until 1964 Robert W. Dean was employed in his own law office in Wausau, Wis. From 1964 until 1978 he was the judge on Marathon County Court Branch I in Wausau. He was a Wisconsin Court of Appeals judge for District III in Wausau from 1978 until his retirement. Mr. Dean also owned and operated the Wausau Realty and Abstract Co. from 1951 until 1963. His public service involvement included being acting village attorney of Alma Center in 1950, acting assistant district attorney for Jackson County in 1950, a Wisconsin State Senator for the 29th Senatorial District from 1959 until 1963, Minority Floor Leader of the Wisconsin Senate in 1962 and 1963, chairman of the American Heart Fund in 1958, and a United Way Board Member. While serving in the state senate, Robert W. Dean sponsored 48 bills and 41 resolutions. He had been a member of the Wausau Elks Lodge, the Wausau Moose Lodge, the Rothschild Lions Club, the Wausau American Legion, the Wausau Eagles Lodge, a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars post and a past post commander, Knight of Columbus 4th Degree Pere Renard, a charter member of the National Conference of Legislative Leaders, and a board member

of the National W. Club of the University of Wisconsin. His legal memberships and connections include the Marathon County Bar Association, the American Bar Association, Wisconsin State Bar Association, Wisconsin Juvenile Judges Association, the Wisconsin County Judges Association, the National Council of Juvenile Judges, and the national College of State Trial Judges. Mr. Dean was politically active as a member of the state and Marathon County Democratic party since 1951. He was elected as a Democratic candidate to the state senate in 1958 and served as Marathon County Democratic Chairman for 3 years, having served as platform chairman for the Wisconsin Democratic party. He was one of the first supporters of President Kennedy's nomination, having helped organize the first Wisconsin state committee for Kennedy, Kennedy for President Group in Wausau, Wis. In 1959, served as 7th District Chairman for Kennedy For President Group and Vice Chairman of the Marathon County Kennedy for President group. After he became a judge in 1964, he could no longer be active in politics. Mr. Dean is survived by seven children, Lucinda Ann Dean, Whitewater, Wis., Daniel William Dean, Fort Collins, Colo., Timothy Robert Dean, Chugiak, Alaska, Robert Peter Dean, Fort Collins, Colo., Kathy Esther Miller Bennett, Colo., Christopher Robin Dean, Poynette, Wis., and Jennifer Holly Andrews, Madison, Wis., six grandchildren, two sisters, Tessie (Walter) Shollin, Escandido, Calif., and Dora Holzhauser, Minneapolis, Minn. [Services will be held at 4 p.m. Monday, Dec. 6, 1999, at Henke-Clarson-Holzhauser Funeral Home, 1010 N. Wright Road, Janesville, with Rev. Herbert Saunders officiating. Visitation will be held from 3 p.m. until 4 p.m. Monday at Henke-Clarson-Holzhauser Funeral Home. Memorials may be made to the Rock Haven Volunteer Services Program.

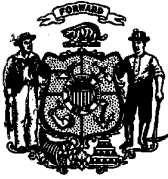

introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
