

1999 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 33

1 **Relating to:** the retirement of Jane Henkel.

2 Whereas, Jane Henkel will retire from the Legislative Council Staff on January
3 31, 2000, after 23 years of service; and

4 Whereas, her potential for providing high quality service to the legislature was
5 already evident in her performance as a student at the University of Wisconsin Law
6 School, where she served on the law review, was on the Dean’s List for 5 semesters,
7 and graduated cum laude; and

8 Whereas, Jane Henkel began work as a staff attorney for the Legislative
9 Council Staff in November 1976; and

10 Whereas, her varied interests and abilities are reflected in the breadth of areas
11 of the law she has influenced through her hard work, including school district
12 boundary changes, open enrollment, public libraries, alcohol beverage laws, truancy,
13 and educational communications technology; and
