## 1999 SENATE RESOLUTION 2

January 4, 1999 - Introduced by Committee on Senate Organization.

- To repeal senate rule 21m; relating to: adopting most of the rules of the 1997 senate
  as the rules of the 1999 senate.
  - Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution continues, except for Senate Rule 21m, the rules of the 1997 senate as the rules of the 1999 senate.

Senate Rule 21m prohibits senate campaign committees from soliciting or accepting campaign contributions from lobbyists or from political action committees that are controlled by organizations that employ or retain lobbyists, except during the campaign period. This resolution repeals that rule.

- 3 **Resolved by the senate, That:**
- **SECTION 1. Rules of the Senate.** The rules of the 1997 Senate shall continue as the rules of the 1999 Senate.
- **SECTION 2.** Senate rule 21m is repealed.
