10. MILK STANDARDS; REPEAL
OBSOLETE LANGUAGE

EXPLANATION:

Dairy plants test milk for its component content, and pay farmers based on the test results. In order to ensure that testing is accurate, dairy plants calibrate their testing equipment using standard milk samples containing known quantities of milk components. The department currently prepares and distributes standard milk samples that are used to calibrate dairy plant milk testing equipment. Under s. 93.06(1s) and 20.115(8)(ga), Stats., the department is authorized to charge dairy plants for the cost of these standards. When the milk standards program was first created, the department received a loan from the general fund to cover program start-up costs. Section 20.115(8)(ga), Stats., directed the department to repay the loan in annual installments using funds derived from dairy plant purchases of milk standards. The department has now repaid the loan in full. This legislation therefore repeals obsolete language requiring the department to make annual loan repayment installments.

STATUTORY LANGUAGE:

SECTION ____ . 20.115(8)(ga) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.115(8)(ga) Milk standards program. All moneys received as payment for milk standards produced and used in the calibration and verification of instruments used for milk component testing and related costs for the milk standards program. ~~On June 30, 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993 and 1994, the department shall make payments, of at least \$10,000 each year, to the general fund from this appropriation for the purpose of reimbursing milk standards program start up costs. The payments shall total an amount equal to \$142,200 by June 30, 1994.~~
